The service of Holy Communion is central to our worship this morning. Reference to it will be made throughout the service. Here are some biblical references from the New Testament, most well known but some less so:

Acts 20: 7 "On the first day of the week we came together to break bread"

John 6: 33-35 "Then Jesus declared, "I am the bread of life"

48-51 Again states "I am the bread of life"

53-58 Further well known words,

Luke 22: 19-20 "And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying "This is my body given to you: do this in remembrance of me". In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you".

Luke 24: 30 "When he was at the table with them, he took bread, gave thanks, broke it and began to give it to them"

Matthew 26: 17-30 is entitled 'The Lord's Supper'

Acts 2: 42-46 entitled 'The Fellowship of the Believers' and states "They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts"

1 Corinthians 11: 17-34 entitled 'The Lord's Supper' and which we read today.
