New window screen

We are proud to display a prominent new feature in our church – indeed, it is unmissable! A "stained-glass-window-effect-screen" now enhances the large window in the chancel above the communion table.

We've always had a dazzle problem with the window – and the new screen is the solution. Since September 2015 Church member Maureen Nye has coordinated 23 students at Rodborough School (that's 40 lunchtimes) to produce a stunning work of art, using hand-motifs from 134 contributors – mainly children, ranging from Rodborough, Green Oak School & Nursery, to the United Church "Godaltots".

The shapes are painted in vivid transparent acrylics and together create a scene based on the Noah's Ark story. The rainbow - depicting God's covenant with mankind - is prominent, along with the ark, and the nativity star is shown as a bridge between heaven and earth. The flood is represented by a huge wave, in the style of Japanese painter Katsushika Hokusai, and incorporates the shapes of currently endangered animals. This vibrant "Helping Hands" screen breathes new life into the church interior and challenges the beholder. Do pop in and see it!
