### **Godalming Quaker Meeting**

#### Remembering all those affected by war

November starts with All Souls Day, when many families remember their loved ones who have died during the last year.

As a nation we also remember UK soldiers killed in war and lay wreaths of red poppies at the national and local war memorials.

As Quakers, we have compassion for all those affected by war, including injured and disabled soldiers and civilians everywhere, and their families. More importantly, our faith calls us to work unceasingly for peace and to live 'in that life and power that takes away the occasion of all wars'.

Therefore Friends choose to wear red and white poppies to remember our responsibility for resolving conflict not with weapons of war but with nonviolent and just means. White poppies were first worn on Armistice Day 1933, mainly by women who were mothers, sisters, widows who had lost loved ones in WW1. Each year, Veterans for Peace UK lay a wreath of red and white poppies at the Cenotaph in Whitehall.

Godalming Friends again prepare to witness to the gospel of peace by wearing a red and white poppy in public and by laying a wreath with both colours at the War Memorial on Remembrance Sunday.
